The Caroline Ouellette Girls Hockey Celebration is a non-profit organization. All proceeds from the Celebration are reinvested in development of players, coaches and officials in women's hockey through our Player to Coach, Introduction to Officiating programs, CCM Get in the Game and U7 Festival. We offer unique components such as on-ice development sessions for goaltenders, the Étoiles Alumni Game and the U13-AAA All-Star Game. We are proud to fully fund the participation of the Étoiles du Québec team taking part in the Quebec Women's Hockey Tournament in the U15-AAA division.



YOUR COMPETITION SITE IS THE DOLLARD-DES-ORMEAUX CIVIC CENTER

The **U12-A, U12-AA, U12-B and U13-AAA division** tournament is taking place at the DDO Civic Centre located at 12001 Salaberry Blvd., Dollard-Des Ormeaux, Québec, H9B 2A7.

The U12, U13 and U15 finals, as well as the U13-AAA All-Star Game, will be played at the Bell Centre.

These Celebration finals will take place at the Bell Centre thanks to a partnership with the Montreal Canadiens. All activities held at the Bell Centre are open to the public. Therefore, all teams, families and friends are welcome to attend the final games at the Bell Centre with your tournament pass or a daily Celebration ticket.

For your information, the U9 and U15 activities are being held at the Étienne-Desmarteau Centre, located at 3430 Bellechasse Street in Montreal.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

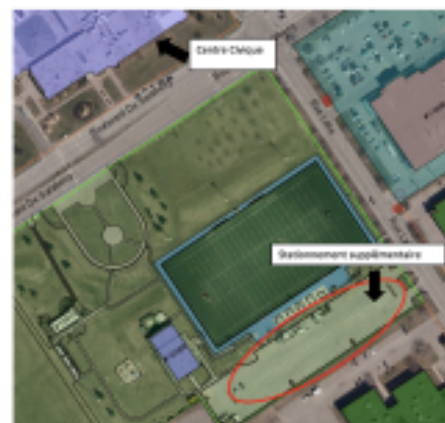

Be sure to read this information before the tournament. And to share it with all members of your team. We please ask that you are comfortable with the procedures of the games in preliminary and elimination rounds.



ENTRANCE & PARKING

Please enter by the pool and library entrance. It will be the only open entrance during the Celebration. Parking is free all around the Civic Center. It happens that parking is full because of all the activities at the Civic Center. Here's a map towards another parking lot.



TEAM REGISTRATION

Team check-in will take place near the spectator entrance at the top of the stairs on the left. You must check in before each of your games to review your game sheet and confirm your jersey color. Teams must bring the game sheets from their last five games. Warm-up pucks will be provided by the Celebration.



INDIVIDUAL PLAYER REGISTRATION

Individual player registration will take place near the spectator entrance of Rink 2 at the top of the stairs. Information regarding your first game will be sent to you by email. Please arrive no later than 75 minutes before your first game. Your coaches will give you your team jersey and hockey socks before the first game. Coaches must check in with the registrar before each game to confirm the presence and/or absence of their players and to sign the game sheet to finalize their lineup. For the following games, coaches have the responsibility to communicate with their players and families the meeting points and schedule. Players must have their water bottle. Warm-up pucks are provided by the Celebration. .



PLAYER OF THE GAME & POST-GAME PROTOCOL

We ask coaches to communicate the number and full name of the player of the game to the scorekeeper about 3 minutes before the end of the 3rd period. At the end of the game, we ask teams to greet each other while keeping their gloves on to avoid any additional contact. Afterward, we ask both teams to quickly line up at their respective blue lines. The presentation of the players of the game will take place.



TICKETS & TOURNAMENT PASSES

Admission is free for players, coaches and staff (up to 5 people) of teams participating in the Celebration. Spectators have the option of purchasing a tournament pass available at admission for \$20 or a day pass for \$8. For those 65 and older, the day pass is \$6 and the tournament pass is \$15.

Those who purchase a tournament pass will receive a bracelet that they must wear for the entire Celebration to access the competition venues without having to present their proof of purchase again. We accept cash only at the entrance. It will also be possible to purchase your ticket via our Zeffy platform at any time upon your arrival at the arena.

Children 12 years and under will be able to enjoy the Celebration for free. All Celebration activities including the on-ice sessions, the Etoiles Alumni game and the U13-AAA All-Star game are included in the cost of admission. Here is the link to purchase Celebration passes. Our special events include the Alumni Game and the 3-on-3 Challenge. We conclude the Celebration with the U13-AAA All-Star game to select the Étoile du Québec team that will participate in the Quebec

Women's Tournament in the U15-AAA division. Goaltenders will participate in an on-ice development session with Olympian Kim St-Pierre. The M7 Festival and the hockey initiation session called *CCM Get in the Game*, for girls who wish to start playing hockey, are also returning.
